

This is the final event in the full series of the Dunamis Project. Each event is self-contained and immensely useful, though maximum benefit obviously comes through taking part in all six. Leadership for each series is drawn from those who have previously participated in the project, for Dunamis continually raises up anointed, experienced spiritual leadership and is not dependent on a small number of 'experts' or celebrities.

Dunamis leadership teams hold themselves accountable to the participants at every event. There is honesty and vulnerability about personal 'success' and 'failures', a genuine desire that no-one be guilty of 'manipulation', and they cultivate mature discernment towards spiritual activity, rather than naive credulity or scepticism.

The full series of Dunamis events covers:-

1. Gateways to Empowered Ministry
2. In the Spirit's Power (spiritual gifts)
3. The Power of Prayer
4. Jesus' Healing Ministry
5. Spiritual Warfare
6. Listening Evangelism

Another track is currently taking place at Abbot Hall, Cumbria

The Dunamis Project is designed to help people experience and live in the reality of this promise. It is a training and equipping event - a retreat in order to advance!

Dunamis is run as an experimental 'workshop' environment where the focus is on learning rather than on teaching. Each event is characterised by:

- + Intercessory prayer cover - both on and off-site.
- + Anointed, Spirit-led worship.
- + Extensive systematic teaching from Scripture plus testimony from personal experience.
- + Discussion and prayer in small groups.
- + A flexible approach to the programme, constantly seeking direction from the Holy Spirit.
- + 'Lab' times - putting into practice the lessons that are being taught.
- + Debriefing - thoughtful critique and evaluation of events and experiences, teaching the process of spiritual discernment.
- + Creating a community of trust and mutual accountability.
